Restore – to re-establish the hopes, dreams and aspirations of young people.

Renew – rebuild and encourage confidence and capabilities.

1. What are the minimum amount of hours we can commission?

The minimum amount of hours that can be commissioned are 10 hours per week.

2. How long does it take to refer and set up a case?

We aim to review all referrals within 2 days. The next step is a teacher parent conference with teaching starting as soon as reasonably possible after.

3. How much do you charge?

We charge a standard rate of £60 per hour.

4. Can we commission joint services?

Our education programme and mentoring programme can be commissioned together.



5. How is the service delivered?

Our services are delivered in person at the home of the young person, in a local library or online.

The most appropriate mode of delivery is determined by the needs of the young person, we also consult the commissioner for the best outcome.

6. When can this service be bought?

Our education and mentoring services are available to be purchased at anytime, this includes the school holidays.

7. How long does the service last?

Our services last as long as required.

8. How can we bring a service to an end?

Our education programme has a notice period of one week.

9. Who can commission this service?

Our education programme can be commissioned by local authorities, schools or parents who elect EOTAS/home school.
